- The book suggests that understanding the past is not enough on its own. What do you think is missing from the way history is often taught?
- How did the themes of motherhood and identity influence your reading of the book?
- After reading, did it change how you think about your personal values? The idea of carrying on a legacy or living your life with more intention? If so, how?
